ANNUAL REPORT OF CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES, 2021 - 2022

School has always meant to be a place that has provided space for students to enter and showcase themselves as learners and participants. With the pandemic and lockdown having its course through the year we had also provided a good arena for our students in their curricular activities. A brief summary of various events such as Clubs, Weekly Competitions, Inter-campus Quizzicle, and National Unity Day (Sardar Vallabhai Patel Competition) is included below.

CLUB ACTIVITIES

Clubs Activities of the year 2021 - 2022 like the Literary Club, Eco Club, Art, Newsletter Club and Craft Club, Cookery Club and the Green Club were held online and offline. The Club Activities were held once a week hosting one club per week and proved to be more situations oriented and useful as they were learning from their home base and were able to experience activities which are part of their everyday life. Virtual Mode was used to organise the International World Earth Day, Independence Day, Teachers Day, Children's Day, Pongal, and Malaysia Day programmes to help pupils appreciate the festivals and social events.

WEEKLY COMPETITIONS

The Academic Year 2021-2022 started with positive hopes during the pandemic and enthusiastic expectations in their 'Weekly Competitions' as always was heartily welcomed by students of grade 6,7 and 8.

As the Pandemic was still taking its toll, Grade 6, Grade 7, and Grade 8 students could not be segregated into the different School-based houses, the competitions were open to all who wanted to participate. The Google classroom was opened for the new set of students along with all the teachers were invited to participate and judge the activities by sharing the link. The best works were awarded an 'E-certificate Of Appreciation' to motivate the budding creators and we it was amazing as we had quite a lot of winners who gave a neck to neck tough to their fellow participant.

Holidays, exams, Internet outages and network connectivity acted as hurdles for the students to participate in the online competition but a small ray of hope kept them going. By January 2021, students were able to compete in weekly class competitions while adhering to the Covid19- guidelines.
